Letter jacket fittings occur during the following months: October, January, March, April

To become eligible to receive a letter jacket from the Klein Forest FFA Chapter, student must always represent the FFA and Klein ISD in a positive manner. A student must show an interest in the affairs of the organization by attending meetings, striving for degrees of membership, and participating in the other organized activities of the chapter. A student must meet all of the following requirements:

- Student must maintain active membership in the Klein Forest FFA Chapter for 2 years.
- Student must actively seek all FFA Degrees such as Greenhand, Chapter, & State FFA Degree.

Ag Mech/Breeding: Division winners (Klein Show); Class Placings or Higher (Majors)

Welding Contest: 1-3 individual placing

Receive their Texas FFA State Degree (Lonestar)

*Major show; Houston, San Antonio, State Fair, Fort Worth, Austin, Shoppas, Blinn

Student may not miss more than 2 FFA meetings a year.

Student must participate in a chapter committee each year.

Student must participate in 2 community service projects each year.

Members must not accumulate more than one P or U in conduct in any class per year.

The chapter will pay for the eligibility of the letter jacket after all requirements are met.
